Student Contribution Fees are a student's contribution to the cost of training and assessment services provided by Look Now Training.

Funding ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Students in Queensland wishing to enrol in an apprenticeship must be employed and signed up as an eligible trainee by an Australian Apprenticeship Support Network.

This qualification is available to persons eligible to undertake an Australian Apprenticeship. They will be required to be signed in to a contract through an Australian Apprenticeship Support Network (ASSN) prior to commencement.

TYPE OF APPRENTICESHIP

- » Full-time apprentices and trainees work and train an average of 38 hours per week and have ongoing employment.
- » Part-time apprentices and trainees are rostered to work on a regular basis, working and training no less than 15 hours per week, averaged over a 4-week cycle.
- » Existing workers may be employed as an apprentice or trainee in a full-time or part-time capacity.
